Competition Program

Individual competitions in the three disciplines:

- Rhythmic Gymnastics,
 - Women's Artistic Gymnastics and
 - Men's Artistic Gymnastics
- and two age groups
- Children and
 - Juniors

There are

- two divisions for Children WAG+MAG
- one division für Juniors WAG+MAG
- one division für Children RG
- one division for Juniors RG

Scoring

1) Team scoring "ASVÖ Cup" *(no change compared to previous version)*

One team consists of max.

- 2 rhythmic gymnasts (Children or Juniors - altogether),
- 4 female artistic gymnasts (Children or Juniors - altogether) and
- 4 male artistic gymnasts (Children or Juniors - altogether).

Each gymnast gets points depending on the place of scoring; the higher the individual result, the higher the points.

The **five best** individual results per team (regardless of discipline) count for the team score as follows:

- every 1st place 25 points
- every 2nd place 20 points
- every 3rd place 15 points
- every 4th place 14 points *and so on... until finally every 17th place gets 1 point. No points for the following places.*

2) Individual scoring *(no change compared to previous version)*

As usual, individual all-around scores determine the best individualist.

3) "Hanspeter Demetz" Trophy

Lastly, the best MAG gymnast on floor earns a special price, the "Hanspeter Demetz" trophy, to honour our recently passed away Tyrolean gymnastics icon Hanspeter Demetz, as floor exercise was his standout piece of apparatus during his career as an artistic gymnast.

Participants

Age categories and requirements

See specific information for each discipline (further below).

Teams:

- 1 team from each foreign town or region
- 1 team "ASVÖ"-Austria
- 1 teams from each Austrian federal state
- up to 2 Tyrolean teams

It is possible to enter additional individual athletes or teams. These will be placed on a waiting list. Their participation will only be confirmed if there will still be free spots left after considering the following upper limits per age categories and division (confirmation to be communicated after the entry deadline).

For organisational reasons, the total number of participants in each division is limited as follows:

- MAG-Children: 36 (1 division)
- WAG-Children: 66 (2 divisions)
- MAG-Juniors 36 (1 division)
- WAG-Juniors 42 (1 division)
- RG Children and Juniors altogether 40

If these limits are exceeded by the registration deadline, preference will be given to those countries which

- a) are affiliated to the ASVÖ
- b) have participated in previous "ASVÖ Youth Cups" and/or
- c) have paid the entry fee and submitted the forms for the participating gymnasts within the given deadline

Competition Fee

The **competition fee** includes competition, lodging and meals (Friday evening until max. Sunday morning):

Second judge per team and per discipline	0.00
other delegation members (driver, parents, etc.)	180.00
Normally the accommodation provides double or multi-bed rooms. For single rooms an additional fee has to be paid per night	25.00

Registration

- Deadline for the registration: **20th February 2025**. The registration is only valid when the completed forms for each division separately have been submitted and the competition fee has been paid.
 - There is **only** the above-mentioned deadline. Any registration submitted afterwards will be *unsuccessful!*
 - The competition fee will be prescribed to each submitter individually within 7 days after the deadline. The Organisation Committee is only going to book rooms for those who will have paid the competition fees within another 7 days.

HB	The following elements count towards the number of elements even if they are executed below horizontal <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Back uprise to handstand- Kip or drop kip to handstand- From hang or support, free hip circle hop to handstand But they don't count for difficulty and element group. The deduction for the E-Score is 0.5 points.

Authorization Of An International Gymnastics Event in Austria


As official national member federation of the International Gymnastics Federation (FIG) we herewith confirm that the
