Participants at the competition automatically agree to be photographed and filmed for live stream or press relations and declare their unreserved agreement to the publication, which is free of charge by the Austrian Gymnastics Federation and other cooperating partners and media.

In case a visa is required to enter Austria the Austrian Gymnastics Federation will be happy to assist each delegation with an official invitation (reference no.), provided that the request is made before 15<sup>th</sup> August 2017 with the respective form. The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, place of birth, home address, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of each delegation member.

The host federation and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG technical regulations foresee that all participating federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their delegation.

The organizers will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the organizers in advance.

The organizers will subsequently offer insurance at the federations own charge at € 5,- per person/day.

#### Difficulties:

## Comp. 1/2: according to FIG 11-12 years rules for WAGC.

- 1. The routine consists of 10 different elements
- 2. only two (2) elements allowed with less than 270° somersault rotation. Each element meeting the requirement must be marked with an asterisk (\*) on the competition card. These requirements cannot be fulfilled by combining them into one element but must be performed as separate elements.
- 3. 1 element landing on the front of the body
- 4. 1 element landing on the back of the body

**Comp. 3/4**: according to FIG 13-14 years rules for WAGC.

- 1. The routine consists of 10 different elements
- 2. only one (1) element allowed with less than 270° somersault rotation. Each element meeting the requirement must be marked with an asterisk (\*) on the competition card. These requirements cannot be fulfilled by combining them into one element but must be performed as separate elements.
- 3. 1 element landing on the back of the body
- 4. 1 element landing on the front of the body
- 5. back somersault with full twist

**Comp. 5/6:** according to FIG 15-16 years rules for WAGC.

- 1. The routine consists of 10 different elements
- 2. only one (1) element allowed with less than 270° somersault rotation. Each element meeting the requirement must be marked with an asterisk (\*) on the competition card. These requirements cannot be fulfilled

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by combining them into one element but must be performed as separate elements.

- 3. one (1) element either landing on the back or front of the body
- 4. Full (back somersault with 1/1 twist)
- 5. Rudi or Rudi ball out, (front somersault with 1 ½ twist or 1 ¼ from back, with 1 ½ twist)

Comp. 7/8 according to FIG 17-18 years rules for WAGC.

- 1. The routine consists of 10 different elements
- 2. only one (1) element allowed with less than 270° somersault rotation. Each element meeting the requirement must be marked with an asterisk (\*) on the competition card. These requirements cannot be fulfilled by combining them into one element but must be performed as separate elements.
- 3. one (1) double front or back somersault with or without twist
- 4. one (1) element with a minimum of 540° of twist and minimum of 360° somersault rotation.
- 5. one (1) element to front or back
- 6. one (1) element from front or back in combination with requirement No. 5

**Comp. 9/10:** FIG A according to Code of Points

Limitations of the difficulty

-12 years: 1,5 pts.

13-14 years: 1,7 pts.

15-16 years: 1,8 pts.

For 11-12 years old, triple somersaults are prohibited For all age groups, quadruple somersaults are prohibited
