FEDERATIONS INVITED	<p>The Organizing Member Federation will invite all FIG Member Federations in good standing according to the following principles:</p> <p>Eligible to participate are National Teams and/ or Regional/ Club teams Junior, nominated by their FIG member federation.</p> <p>Starting positions are limited to 18 teams for men, including FIG senior competition. Therefore the organizers reserve the right to cancel the participation of teams due to limited starting positions.</p>				
AGE LIMITS	<p>MAG: Junior: born in 2000 - 2004 All gymnasts must have a valid FIG licence until the end of the event.</p>				
DELEGATIONS	<p>Each international team...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> has to accredit up to 2 coaches per team. <input type="checkbox"/> must nominate at least 1 judge per team (1 for junior). All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet. <input type="checkbox"/> gets the opportunity to accredit one additional person (head of delegation, medical, driver...).

EVENT FORMAT	<p>MAG Competition Format:</p> <p>age limit -> according to the UEG Competition rules.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> 5-4-3: Up to five gymnasts build a team, up to four of them compete for the team at each apparatus, the top three scores per apparatus count for the team results. <input type="checkbox"/> All gymnasts of a team are allowed to compete a complete individual all around competition. <input type="checkbox"/> Gymnasts born 2000 to 2004 will be judged according to FIG CoP junior rules 2018. <input type="checkbox"/> Individual gymnasts (without a team) may register but are only accepted, if starting slots remain available after nominative registration deadline.

CANCELLATION POLICY	<p>For any and all cancellations, partial or total, made between January 22th and March 19th, a cancellation fee of 75% of the total accommodation costs has to be paid to the organizers. The entry fee is non-refundable.</p> <p>For any and all cancellations, partial or total, made after March 19th, a cancellation fee of 100% of the total costs has to be paid to the organizers.</p>
FINAL BANQUET	<p>After the competition the Organizers offer a farewell banquet for all delegation members at the cost of EUR 23,- per person.</p>
